THE MUSIC OF JARED REHBERG

Jared Rehberg was born somewhere around Saigon, Vietnam in 1974. There are no birth records or legal documents available. He spent 8 to 9 months at the An Lac Orphanage under the tender care of Betty Tisdale and Madame Ngai. They called him Vu Tien Anh. The 1985 Television movie "The Children of An Lac" starring Shirley Jones brought Betty's heroic journey in Vietnam to the silver screen. On the first week of April in 1975, Vu Tien Anh came to America on the airlift of children called Operation Babylift. Over 2,000 orphaned children came to America with hope for love, family, shelter, food and the opportunity for a better life. Betty Tisdale's story is published in the first serving of Chicken Soup for the Soul, called "She Saved 219". On May 7, 1975, Vu Tien Anh was adopted at York, Pennsylvania. A Superstar was born. Many exciting years of musical instruments, lessons, live theater, acrylic painting and general athletics lay ahead.

After meeting hundreds of adoptees at the 25th Reunion of Vietnamese Adoptees, Jared found new inspiration to give back to the many selfless people who gave him so much more. His first album, *Waking Up American* includes heartfelt songs dedicated to his birth parents, the world through the eyes of an orphan in Vietnam today, a historic look at *Operation Babylift*, and other universal issues. The true mix of modern Folk guitar, current Pop and Hip-Hop beats and raw passionate vocals makes a fine collection of Universal Folk Pop songs that will be heard by generations of children who long for a better life and a better world for their children.

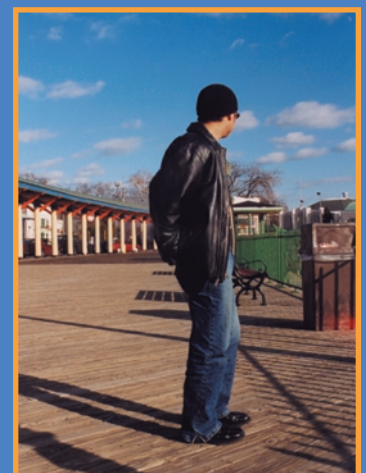
